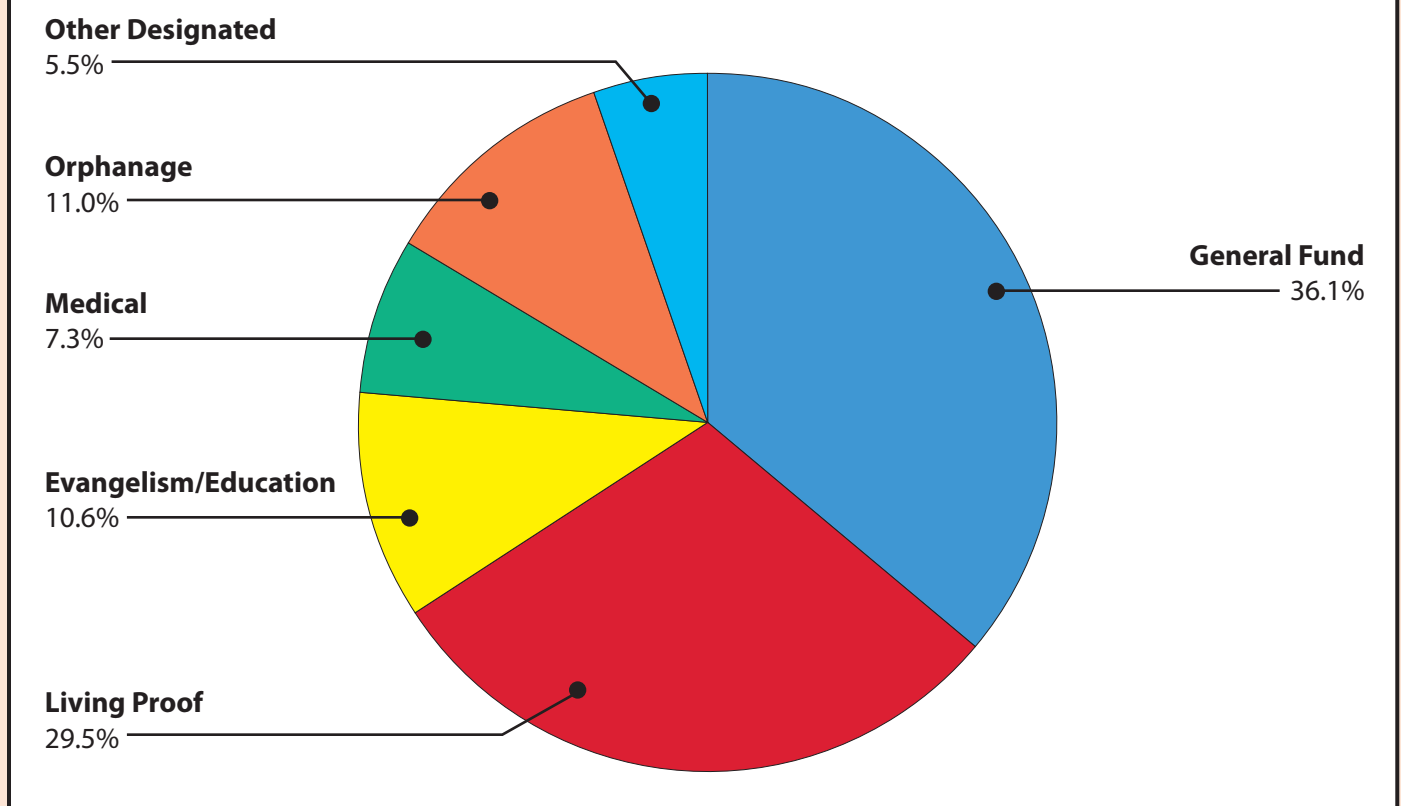
## Hippo Valley 2019 Financial Notes

- 80% of expenses were spent on the field in Zimbabwe meeting our goal for 2019
- Mission Thrift Store income surpassed our goal by almost \$20,000, bringing in \$59,000 to support our orphan ministry
- We are now paying high school fees for 366 Living Proof students
- Our orphan sponsorship income increased by 15%
- Living Proof sponsorship income increased by 5%

## Goals for 2020

- Recruit donors to fully sponsor our 11 new orphans
- Complete first school building at Gutu
- Continue improving communication between sponsors and Living Proof students

American Christians are the most generous people in the world! Nearly 94% of funding for world evangelism comes from Christians and Churches in the United States! This is significant! This is why, in my opinion, God continues to bless this great nation of ours!

We recognize and appreciate your faithful support so very much.

For this reason, it is a priority with us to give a concise and yet thorough financial accounting to our friends and partners. Having personally spent more than 25 years in the church and preaching ministry, I know firsthand what church leaders, mission teams and generous supporters want to know from a mission they support:

- You want to support a mission that handles God's funds with integrity and uses those funds to reach as many people for Christ as possible.
- You want to know if lost people are getting saved.
- You want to know what percentage of the money you give is actually being used on the mission field.
- You want to know if discipleship, Christian education and preacher training are taking place.
- You want to know if the orphans are being cared for in Jesus' name.
- You want to know if the next generation of leaders (the children) are being reached, equipped, trained and deployed for work in the Kingdom.

Well, this is what HVCM attempts to do each and every year. Certainly, 2019 was challenging due mostly to the collapsing economy in Zimbabwe. However, in spite of all of this, we have completed the building and remodeling of the health clinic at Dine and are nearly finished at Rushangarumwe. We have planted two new churches in growing areas. Our Living Proof program has now grown to over 1700 children and this past fall we hosted the first ever Living Proof College Days at Zimbabwe Christian College with more than 800 kids attending and at least 100 made decisions for Christ!

We have supplied NIV Study Bibles and great textbooks to all Zimbabwe Christian College students as well as books and lecturers for our 21st Annual Zimbabwe Preaching Summit. HVCM currently sponsors 10 students at Zimbabwe Christian College through the Mike Grooms Preaching Scholarship and the Bob Hoffman International Scholarship. We are investing big in preacher training!

In spite of the challenges, 2020 is shaping up to be an exciting year for HVCM! At the time of this writing, construction is underway for our long awaited 28th mission school in the region of Gutu! Thousands of children in that area will benefit and the Kingdom will advance!

So, please look this report over and do not hesitate to call our offices with any questions you might have about this or anything. Please continue to keep us in your prayers as the challenges are always before us. If you follow world news, you probably know that Zimbabwe is going through very difficult times economically. However, Zimbabwe continues to be a field white unto harvest! The mission is growing, expanding and impacting Zimbabwe as it has for 64 years now!
